



Infection: An Overview

Description:

The course considers infectious disease from several perspectives and explores the underlying biology, epidemiology, clinical evaluation, diagnosis and treatment. Control of infections through to infectious disease is considered and various types of infection including fungal, bacterial and viral and the role of laboratory testing in diagnosis, treatment and control will be discussed. Urinary tract infections (UTI's), gastric diseases, respiratory infections, skin, soft tissue and bone infections will be reviewed and the programme will also include the issues surrounding community versus hospital acquired infection and include a session focussing specifically on sepsis and septic shock.

Detailed case studies will provide an understanding of strategies used in practice and discussion will be inherent throughout the course.

Who should attend?

Healthcare's courses are designed for both medical and non-medical staff within the pharmaceutical industry. This course is suitable for clinical research, medical information, regulatory affairs, biometrics and strategic marketing personnel.
